Saskatchewan Human Rights Commission Employment Equity Statistical Report

Introduction

Section 47 of *The Saskatchewan Human Rights Code* gives the Saskatchewan Human Rights Commission the authority to promote equality in the workplace by approving employment equity plans. The Commission uses the term “sponsor” to refer to employers with approved plans. There are currently 35 approved plans, in sponsor workplaces employing over 37,000 individuals in Saskatchewan.

The Commission has approved equity plans for four designated groups: women,¹ Aboriginal people, persons with disabilities, and members of visible minorities. Employers with approved plans establish their own short-term goals and timetables, and the Commission establishes the long-term goals of employment equity. These goals simply reflect the representation of the designated groups in Saskatchewan’s working age population as set out in the following table.

Saskatchewan’s Aboriginal population is growing at a faster rate than other parts of the population. The long-term goal for employment of Aboriginal people increases by 2.3

percent every year. For the province as a whole, for example, the goal is 12.5 percent in 2002, 12.8 percent in 2003, 13.0 percent in 2004, 13.4 percent in 2005 and 13.7 percent in 2006. Because there is a higher proportion of Aboriginal people in certain regions, the current long-term goal for their workforce representation is 14 percent in North Battleford, 25 percent in Prince Albert, and 81 percent in Northern Saskatchewan.⁴

This Report

Table A shows the workforce representation of the designated groups for all employers with equity plans approved by the Saskatchewan Human Rights Commission. It also provides comparative figures for the past four years. Because employment equity is concerned not only with entry level jobs but also with opportunities for advancement, Table B shows the representation of the designated groups in senior and middle management.

In Tables A and B, figures indicate total number of jobs, whether they are permanent or non-permanent, full-time or part-time.
