

## Human Rights at Work: The Duty to Accommodate A Full-day Seminar for Employers and Unions

The Saskatchewan Human Rights Commission (SHRC) and the Public Legal Education Association of Saskatchewan (PLEA) are pleased to offer a full-day seminar to employers and union representatives wishing to develop their human rights skills.

The program will include:

- an overview of rights and responsibilities under *The Saskatchewan Human Rights Code*;
- a description of the complaint process;
- key topics such as harassment, discrimination prevention, and the duty to accommodate; and
- a brief update on important human rights decisions.

The day will conclude with a Q and A session for participants with specific questions. Presenters will include SHRC staff members, including the Supervisor of Mediations & Investigations, Senior Staff Solicitor, Policy Analyst, and others.
